Changes to Trident Education Requirements

In an ALAUX announcement in February 2007 it was announced that all Auxiliarists participating in Marine Safety programs must have ICS 100 and IS 700 completed by 30 June 2006. This same ALAUX also announced that ICS 200 and IS 800 were required by any member qualifying in the Trident program by 30 Sept 2006. It also stated that members must be fully compliant by 31 Dec 2007.

As a result, the requirements for the Trident device are changed to include the addition of ICS 200, IS 700 and IS 800. This change was reviewed and approved by NEXCOM.

Since the MS Training Ribbon requires completion of all educational requirements for the Trident device, these courses are now required for the MS Training Ribbon also.

This change is effective immediately.
